

# WORLD PEACE

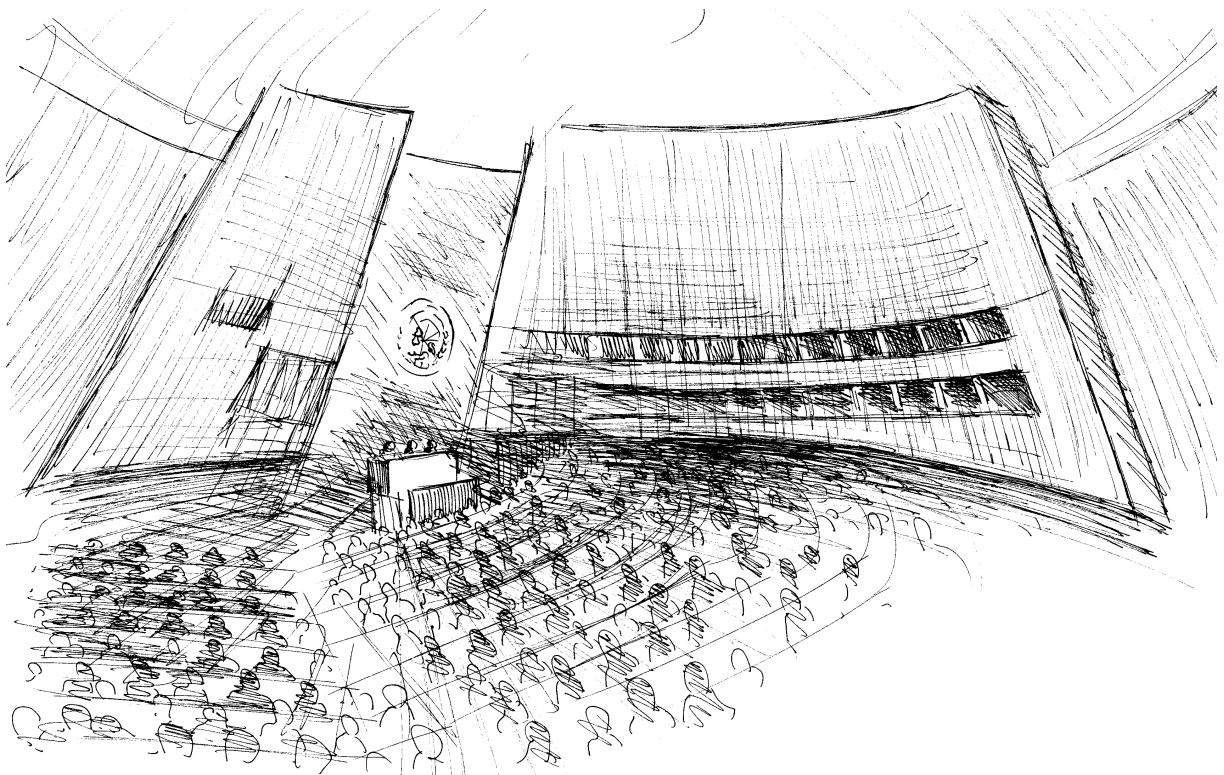
Bahá'u'lláh continued to write to the leaders and people of the world, urging them to listen to the Words of God. He said that they could still achieve world peace and this would one day lead to the Most Great Peace when everyone will have recognised this new message from God.

As a start, He called upon mankind to hold a world conference which all the rulers and kings of the earth must attend. There they should agree that no country would ever fight another country. If the leader of one country did fight another, then all the others must rise up and prevent him. Then there would be no need for so many weapons of war.

Bahá'u'lláh also said that the day will come when one universal language will be taught, so that as well as speaking our own languages, everyone will be able to understand each other better.

Bahá'u'lláh said:

*"The earth is but one country, and mankind its citizens."*
