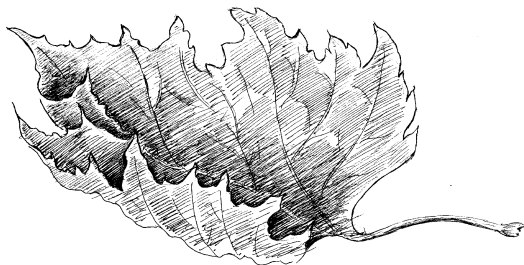


BAHÁ'U'LLÁH DOES GOD'S WILL

Bahá'u'lláh did not go to school, but God taught Him the knowledge of all things. When He was in the underground dungeon, He said:

“This thing is not from Me, but from one Who is Almighty and All-Knowing. And He bade Me lift up My voice between earth and heaven, and for this there befell Me what hath caused the tears of every man of understanding to flow.”

Because He told the people He had a message from God, Bahá'u'lláh was exiled from His country, poisoned, and put in prison. It was while He was in the Prison of 'Akká that one of His dearly loved sons died when he fell through a hole in the roof while saying his prayers.



Bahá'u'lláh was like a leaf which the wind blew from place to place. He went wherever God sent Him, and He only said what God told Him to say.
