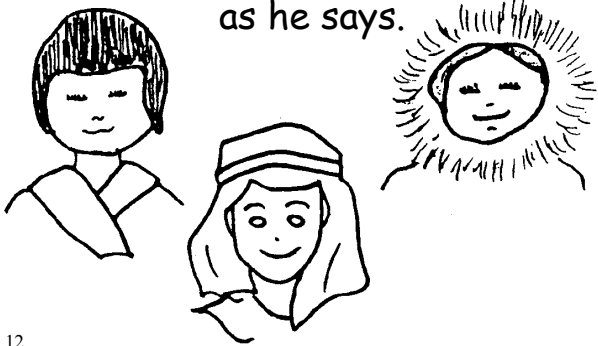


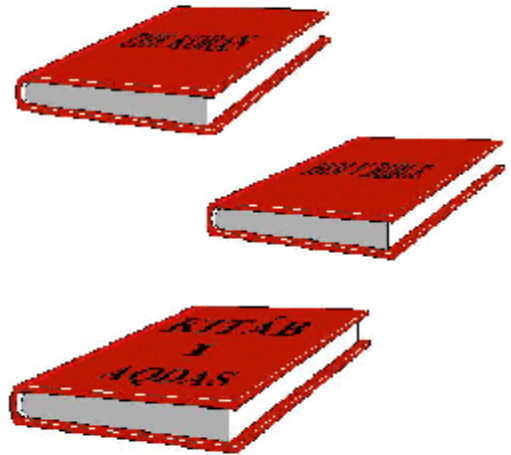

Each Messenger from God lives in this world for a short time only, but His Teachings are followed for much longer. So it helps people if they have somewhere to turn for help.

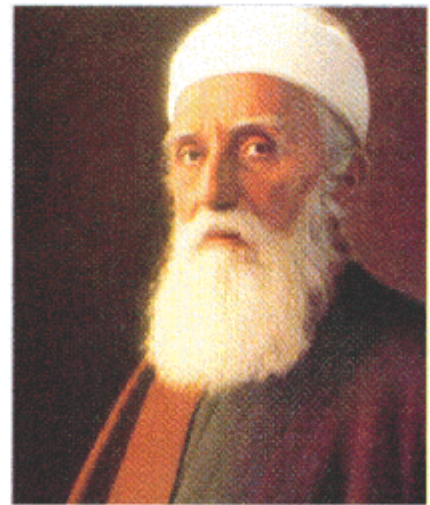

We can learn to truly recognise Him by trying hard to understand properly the teachings of the Messenger in our own age: Bahá'u'lláh.

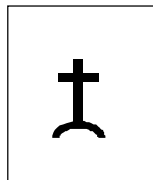
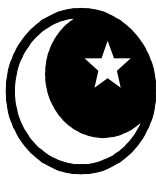


Each Messenger from God tells us that another Messenger will come. Each of us must try to understand the real truth about God so that we will recognise His next Messenger.
