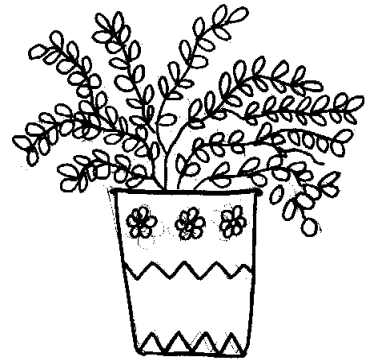
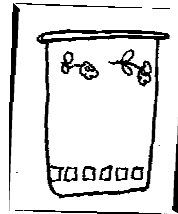
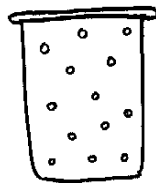
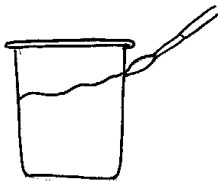




Let's Recycle

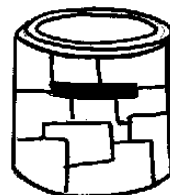
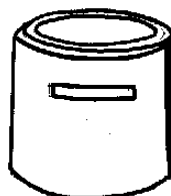
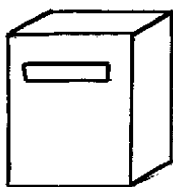
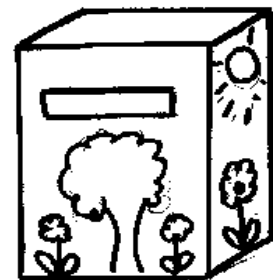
Turn your empty yogurt pots into pretty plant holders.

1. Paint a good strong base colour onto the pots.
2. Allow to dry properly.
3. Decorate each pot with a colourful design.
4. When dry place some stones in the base of each pot, fill with compost and pop in a little plant.



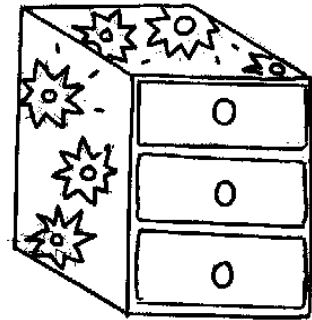
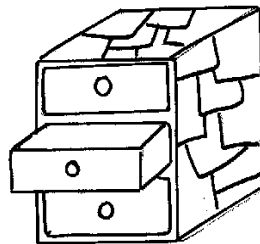
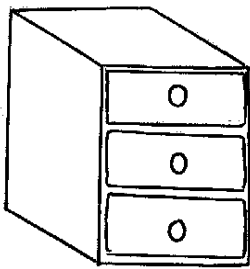
Turn cardboard containers into money boxes.

1. Make a neat slit for putting in the coins.
2. Glue on pieces of cut up newspaper. Put several layers.
3. When it's dry, paint with bright colours.

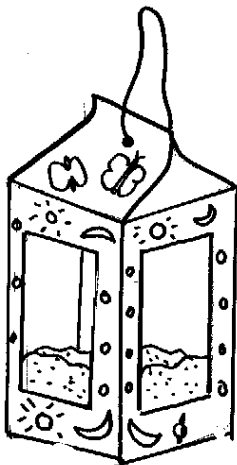


Make a tiny chest of drawers to keep all your bits and pieces tidy.

1. Glue three empty match boxes on top of each other.
2. Cover the whole outside surface, except the front and back, with pieces of glued newspaper.
3. Allow to dry, then decorate with bright paints.
4. Stick buttons on the front of the drawers to look like knobs, or use paper fasteners.



Make a bird feeder for the winter



1 Cut panels out of an empty milk carton.

2. Decorate the outside and thread string through the top for a hanger.

3 In a bowl save all the fat from the grill pan and the frying pan. Keep it in the fridge till you have enough.

4 Warm it slightly to soften and mix in some wild

bird seeds, breadcrumbs or chopped nuts.

5 Put the mixture in the bottom of your feeder

6. Hang it in a tree out of the reach of cats.
